In compliance with U.S. Immigration regulations, Emory & Henry College cannot provide you with the Certificate of Eligibility needed to apply for a student visa until you have demonstrated that you can be financially responsible for all your anticipated educational and living expenses while you are in the United States. It is for this reason that we must ask you to provide us with written verification of the sources and amount of your financial support. YOUR FINANCIAL VERIFICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A BANK STATEMENT, A SPONSOR'S LETTER OF GUARANTEE, OR A LETTER CONFIRMING A SCHOLARSHIP OR LOAN. An acceptable financial document must have been issued no longer than nine months before you intend to enroll. Copies of these documents should be kept to present to the U.S. Consulate at the visa interview and to the U.S. Immigration officers at your port of entry. Please return the completed form and required documents to the Office of Admissions, P.O. Box 947, Emory, Virginia 24327-0010 USA.

Costs: See the enclosed list of estimated expenses for your first year of study.

Work: You should not consider employment as a means of support for yourself or your family. International students can work on campus, but jobs are hard to find and pay minimum wage. Regarding work off campus, U.S. Immigration regulations prohibit international students from working off campus during their first year in the U.S. and make it extremely difficult to obtain permission to work in succeeding years as well. The spouse and children of a student on an F-1 visa are not permitted to work under any circumstances.
